DEAR PARISHIONERS, We are sad to inform you that after the announcements by the Victorian Government this week, placing the entire state under lockdown for at least one week, we have made the following decisions:

- Church and Adoration Chapel will be closed for public prayers and adoration from midnight tonight.
 - Weekday Mass will continue to be livestreamed every day at 9.30am and Weekend Mass at 9.00am on Sunday until further notice. You can only participate online.
 - The priests will be available for Sick calls.
 - Celebration of Sacraments such as Baptism and First Communion ceremonies have been suspended until further notice.
 - The Confirmation Retreat schedule to take place on Wednesday 2nd June and the Confirmation Ceremonies on 4th and 5th June has been postponed. A new date will be announced later.
 - Parish Office will be closed but staff will be working from home. If you need any assistance, please contact us during office times on 5996 1985.
 - Lectors who will be reading during the livestream Masses will be directly contacted from the Parish Office.

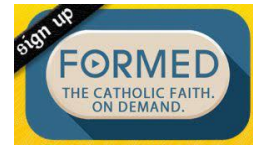
