



Shelford Girls' Grammar Principal's Poetry Prize for Year 7 and 8 Students

Year 7 and 8 students are invited to write a poem presenting a considered reflection on one of the following topics –

- how a chosen event, idea, person or movement has had impact in the world;
- why a chosen event, idea, person or movement is important; or
- what can or must be done to make the world a better place.

Length: 350 words or less

Eligibility: The Principal's Poetry Prize is open to all students in Year 7 and 8.

Due date: Submission by email by 3:10pm, Friday 30th July, 2021. Entries can be submitted via email to Mr Hill (Middle Years Coordinator) at thill@shelford.vic.edu.au.

Selection: Mr Hill and Ms Stock (Head of English 7-10) will create an honour list from the entries. A winning entry will be selected from the honour list by the Principal, Ms Brennan.

Prize: \$100 book voucher, awarded in a School Assembly. The winning poem will be performed in Assembly, published in the Q Magazine and on the School's website.
