**Pupil Free Days:** The service is operating on all pupil free days during week 11 for all families. Please contact the director if you require care for any of these days. No cancellations will be accepted in accordance with the cancellation policy.

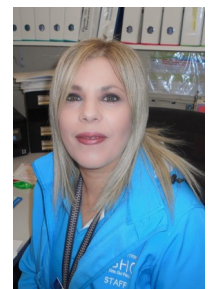
