Long hair (shoulder length and longer) must be tied back with a blue or black hair tie, and we ask that headbands also be in the school colours. Children should not wear jewellery to school and not have painted or long fingernails.

SCHOOL-YARD ROUTINES

To help manage the number of balls in the yard, we provide specific play equipment for students during recess and lunch. We kindly ask that children **do not bring their own** basketballs, footballs, soccer balls, or other play equipment from home.

Additionally, for **safety reasons**, we ask that children **do not use the Adventure Playground before or after school.** As this area is not supervised by staff during these times, it is an important **occupational health and safety requirement.**

We appreciate your support in keeping our school environment safe and wellorganised for all students.

PARKING ON JAMES STREET

Please be vigilant when dropping off, and especially pickingup your children. The area in front of the school on James St is a **'Kiss and Go' area only** and not a designated parking area. We ask that you do not leave your car unattended in the **'Kiss and Go'** zone as it is a 2-minute 'drop-off' area only. Parking in this area causes congestion along James St and puts our children at risk when cars are double parked and children are moving in and out of traffic on the street.



The safety of our children is paramount and we ask for your support in adhering to the existing parking restrictions.

SCHOOL FEES AND LEVIES

In week 3 of the term, you will receive an email regarding the 2025 fees and levies notice. This year, our school fees and levies are increasing slightly. This includes the introduction of a Capital Levy of \$150.00 per family, which has become necessary following last year's extensive roof restoration work.

A breakdown of the 2025 fees and levies are below:

- Family Fee \$2550.00 (per family)
- Capital Levy \$150.00 (per family)
- Prep-Year 4 Levy \$350.00 (per child)
- Year 5-6 Levy \$410.00 (per child)
- Year 3/4 Camp \$180.00 (per child)
- Year 5/6 Camp \$340.00 (per child)
