Pilgrimage to St. Patrick's Cathedral & Tour of Mary MacKillop Heritage Centre

Join us as we close the Jubilee Year with something truly special. Pope Francis invited all Catholics to take part in the Year of Grace by receiving the Jubilee Plenary Indulgence — a grace-filled gift of healing and renewal in Christ.

To obtain the Indulgence, pilgrims are asked to go to Reconciliation, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the Holy Father's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary), during, before, or shortly after visiting a designated Pilgrim site.

While the pilgrimage can be made anytime during the Jubilee Year, we thought it would be especially meaningful to share the experience together.

We warmly invite you to a special Mass for our combined parish community at St Patrick's Cathedral, a designated Pilgrim site.

Event: Mass—Saturday 13 December, 9.30 am

Where: St Patrick's Cathedral, 1 Cathedral Place, East Melbourne

After Mass, we invite you to walk with us to the Mary MacKillop Heritage Centre (362 Albert St, East Melbourne) for a private tour — \$10 per person, with optional morning tea for \$15.

To fulfil the Jubilee Indulgence, we encourage you to attend Reconciliation at St Joseph's on Thursday 18 December at 7.30 pm (Advent series), or during regular times listed in the bulletin.

First Reading Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12 A reading from the prophet Ezekiel

The angel brought me to the entrance of the Temple, where a stream came out from under the Temple threshold and flowed eastwards, since the Temple faced east. The water flowed from under the right side of the Temple, south of the altar. He took me out by the north gate and led me right round outside as far as the outer east gate where the water flowed out on the right-hand side. He said, 'This water flows east down to the Arabah and to the sea; and flowing into the sea it makes its waters wholesome. Wherever the river flows, all living creatures teeming in it will live. Fish will be very plentiful, for wherever the water goes it brings health, and life teems wherever the river flows. Along the river, on either bank, will grow every kind of fruit tree with leaves that never wither and fruit that never fails; they will bear new fruit every month, because this water comes from the sanctuary. And their fruit will be good to eat and the leaves medicinal.'

For the foundation, nobody can lay any other than the one which has already been laid, that is Jesus Christ. Didn't you realise that you were God's temple and that the Spirit of God was living among you? Gospel of John 2:13-22 A reading from the holy Gospel according to **Iohn**

Just before the Jewish Passover Jesus went up to Jerusalem, and in the Temple he found people selling cattle and sheep and pigeons, and the money changers sitting at their counters there. Making a whip out of some cord, he drove them all out of the Temple, cattle and sheep as well, scattered the money changers' coins, knocked their tables over and said to the pigeon-sellers, 'Take all this out of here and stop turning my Father's house into a market'. Then his disciples remembered the words of scripture: Zeal for your house will devour me. The Jews intervened and said, 'What sign can you show us to justify what you have done?' Jesus answered, 'Destroy this sanctuary, and in three days I will raise it up'. The Jews replied, 'It has taken forty-six vears to build this sanctuary: are you going to raise it up in three days?' But he was speaking of the sanctuary that was his body, and when Jesus rose from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the scripture and the words he had said.

Amendments to Euthanasia laws—Petition Signing—This Weekend

Legislation to amend the Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2017passed through the Victorian Parliament's lower house on 30 October and will come before the upper house on 12 November. All Victorian Catholic bishops have asked us to act and pray **NOW**. A letter to the five upper house members (who represent residents in our partnership parishes) is at the back of the church/foyer urging our five MPs to vote against the amendments that specifically: Removes the right of conscientious objection for doctors, health professionals, and Catholic institutions — forcing participation in VAD.

Please sign the letter, print your name and write your address and **hand over** to the designated **PPLT member/safeguarding** officer at your church: Moses/Melanie at St Joseph's, Jim, Rosie or Ophelia at Holy Spirit, Enri at St Mary's, Fran at St Anthony's / St Mary's 5:30pm.
