# My Time, Our Place at OSHC: Our Program

This term our program focus will be on the individual child; looking at self identity: Who am I? Who are my friends? Who is a part of my family? What things am I good at? Etc. These factors help educators get a clearer understanding of the child and their needs, strengths and interests whilst establishing and building on trusting relationships between children and educators.

This program joins in with the environments practice of school-aged care educators where children's learning is connected with the environment around them, allowing children to learn experientially from the people and places within their everyday lives.

Our new program layout has been a success and we have continued to use this approach which allows for increased spontaneity and flexibility to the needs and interests of our children.

<u>Reception students</u>: During the first 4 weeks of the term an OSHC Educator will be located in the quadrangle with our colorful 'Freddy Fish'. Freddy Fish helps the children identify the OSHC educators in the crowd of people and reassures them who we are if they forget. Older siblings are also encouraged to help the younger children walk to and from OSHC.



<u>A few reminders</u>: Please ensure you have filled out a new enrolment form for your child/ren prior to commencing OSHC; existing families <u>must</u> also fill out a new form to update all records. Thank you to those parents who have updated and returned their enrolment forms. If you haven't updated a new enrolment form for the year 2015, could you please do so as soon as possible. Enrolment forms are available at the service for you to collect.

Also please ensure if your child/ren requires a permanent booking you need to fill out a green 'permanent booking' form (bookings do not roll over from previous terms or years).

If your child/ren requires casual bookings please advise us ASAP to ensure we have vacancies on the dates you need. Casual bookings are best suited for families that require different days/ sessions rather than the same booking each week. Please come and see the Director or our friendly OSHC educators to discuss any questions you may have.

<u>Pupil Free Day:</u> The Pupil Free Day will be held on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2015(week 6). A notice will be emailed to parents and also can be collected from the OSHC room. Please indicate whether you require care for your child/ren for that day. We will require a minimum of 15 bookings to operate the service. You will be notified by Monday 23rd February 2015 (week 5) if the service will be operating.

<u>Menu</u>: Please ensure you check the front notice board for the OSHC weekly menu. If your child does not like the meal that is programmed. please ensure your child has alternative snacks for that afternoon. Also please advise OSHC educators if your child has specific dietary requirements such as gluten free, lactose free etc.

<u>Sun Safety:</u> Remember that we follow the same sun safety rules as the school which means all children are required to wear hats outside as well as sunscreen. If your child is allergic to the sunscreen we provide please bring an alternative. Note that we do not provide spare hats, so if your child does not bring a hat they must stay inside or under the shade of the OSHC verandah.

<u>Vacation Care Program:</u> Vacation Care booklets will be available on <u>Monday 16th March</u> from the school website, the front office and OSHC room. The last day for bookings will be <u>Friday 2nd April 2015</u>.
