

2025 UNCLOUD VICTORIAN METRO SC CHAMPIONSHIPS EVENT INFORMATION

Dear Swimmers & Clubs,

We hope you are getting excited for the 2025 UNCLOUD Victorian Metropolitan SC Championships this weekend. Please see below some relevant information for the upcoming event.

Accreditation: Accreditation for coaches, team managers and para carer support will be available for collection in club packs only, from the top of the stairs, behind the grandstand in the indoor pool or from the Swimming Victoria office between 11am – 3pm Friday 25th July. Swimmers do not require accreditation for this event.

Strictly only those with accreditation can get access to the accreditation only areas/pool deck. No parents/guardians can access pool deck.

We encourage all **Team Managers** & **Coaches** to join our WhatsApp Group Chat, where key event information will be shared during the event. Click here to join.

Timekeepers will not be used during this event, as Hawk-Eye will be in operation as back-up timing and recording infractions.

Self-Marshalling will be in place for all swimmers. Please find the self-marshalling procedure here.

Top three finishers will be announced by the commentary team through live commentary into the grandstands and through livestream. Medallists will be displayed on the scoreboard. Results will then be available via Meet Mobile (unofficial) and printed behind the grandstand. Medallists can then collect medals from the medal presentation desk located on pool deck. SV Backdrop and the dais will be in the main foyer for photos.

For **Distance Events** at all SV Championships, anyone swimming in a 400m, 800m and/or 1500m event must check in at the SV Desk on pool deck, or using the QR Code linked in the meet program 1 hour prior to their scheduled race time. Failure to check in will result in heats being merged and that lane no longer being available.

No fins or paddles allowed in the competition pool. This is a request by MSAC to ensure that the touchpads and timing equipment do not get damaged.

This event will be **live streamed** via our YouTube channel.
