



## Free Dental Care is not just for Children of Health Care Card Holders.

Children and youth who **attend public dental clinics will**  
**NOT incur out of pocket expenses** with the Child Dental Benefit Schedule  
**NO FEES ~ YOU WILL BE BULK BILLED!**

On January 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, the government introduced the new **Child Dental Benefit Scheme**. Families who receive **Family Tax Benefit Part A** or a relevant Australian Government payment will receive a letter outlining their eligibility.

It entitles all eligible **children aged 2-17 years old** to general dental care up to the **value of \$1000 over 2 years**.

**Our normal dental care** continues to operate for **all 0-12 year old children and eligible 13-17 year old youth at no cost**. (Youth must be a holder or dependant of a health care or pensioner concessioner card holder, in out-of-home care provided by Department of Human Services or in Custodial Care).

Following their treatment, your child will be placed on our **patient recall system** and receive a reminder letter when their next appointment is due.
