PROCEDURES FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE UNWELL



Child is sent to Office (with red Sick Bay Pass)



Office staff take temperature & monitor for 10 mins (for symptoms)



Parent rung – to collect child.

Office staff must *sight*the negative test result
before student can
enter school

(if you receive the negative test, please forward to office)

(Just tummy-ache etc)

Child can return when well.

Is it potentially COVID-related? **

NSW Health has clarified what "flu-like symptoms" are:

Any student who attends school with **flu-like symptoms** will be **sent home** and **MUST be tested** for COVID-19. The student is only allowed to come back to school once a <u>copy of their negative</u> test result is received (you can screen-shot the test result and send it on Dojo).

Other reported symptoms (B) include: Symptoms (A) of COVID-19 include: fatigue runny nose fever (37.5° or higher) muscle pain cough joint pain sore/scratchy throat headache shortness of breath diarrhoea loss of smell or nausea/vomiting loss of taste loss of appetite. Flu-like symptoms include: any of (A) or a combination of (B). So – ONE symptom from the A list (eg a persistent cough) **OR....** 2 or more symptoms from the B list.
