

# PROCEDURES FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE UNWELL



Child is sent to Office (with red Sick Bay Pass)







Office staff take temperature & monitor for 10 mins (for symptoms)



Parent rung – to collect child.

## *Is it potentially COVID-related? \*\**

 Office staff must <b>sight the negative test result</b> before student can enter school  (if you receive the negative test, please forward to office)	

## ***Is it potentially COVID-related? \*\****

NSW Health has clarified what “flu-like symptoms” are:

Any student who attends school with **flu-like symptoms** will be **sent home** and **MUST be tested** for COVID-19. The student is only allowed to come back to school once a copy of their negative test result is received (you can screen-shot the test result and send it on Dojo).

Symptoms (A) of COVID-19 include:

- fever (37.5 ° or higher)
- cough
- sore/scratchy throat
- shortness of breath
- loss of smell or
- loss of taste

Other reported symptoms (B) include:

- fatigue
- runny nose
- muscle pain
- joint pain
- headache
- diarrhoea
- nausea/vomiting
- loss of appetite.

Flu-like symptoms include: any of (A) or a combination of (B).

So – **ONE** symptom from the A list (eg a persistent cough)

**OR....**

**2 or more** symptoms from the B list.
