350+ local staff, including academic and business leaders. All of our teachers are Tanzanian.

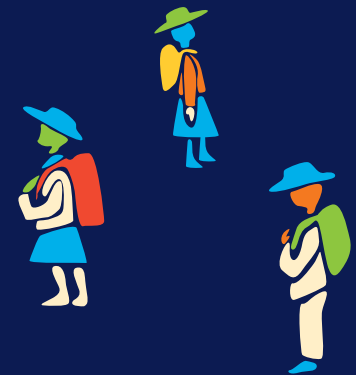
