In 2016 the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis marked a Jubilee for Prisoners. Today is Prison Sunday, the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference recalls the words of the Holy Father Pope Francis: "The task of a chaplain is to let the prisoners know that the Lord is inside them. No cell is so isolated that it can keep the Lord out. He is there. He cries with them, works with them, hopes with them. His paternal and maternal love arrives everywhere." Today we pray for prisoners, their families and especially the Chaplains and the Pastoral Care Workers who minister to them.
