Welcome to Term 2...

We hope you had a restful and enjoyable Easter break and holiday. Welcome to Term 2!

This term we will be learning about Australian history (Events That Shaped Australia, including Federation), the causes and effects of these events and will write recounts of events from the past.

Please help your child develop positive learning habits and organisational skills by encouraging them to complete their homework tasks each week.

- **Reading:** at least 15 minutes, 2-3 times a week and write this in your diary with a parent signature.

Students will be responsible for sharing with their classroom teacher each Friday the reading they have completed.

- **Multiplication Facts:** say, write and play suggested games to learn facts until all are mastered (up to 12 times tables)
- **Diary:** please sign each week regarding your child's completed homework.

This is a friendly reminder that students are required to wear their **sport uniform only on the Grade 6 sport day.**

Weeks 2 – 6: Mondays and Thursdays.

OUR TERM 2 LEARNING INTENTIONS

Religious Education

- We are learning to describe characteristics of relationships and how relationships can change over time.
- We are learning about the family to which we belong and the importance of family.
- We are learning to explain significant transitions in human development and ways in which people deal with them.
- We are learning about the physical and emotional changes during puberty as a part of God's gift of life to each person, and how these changes can affect family dynamics and relationships.

English

- We are learning to apply reading strategies whilst reading a class novel (Us Mob Walawurru and Free Diving).
- We are learning to write a factual recount, character analysis, personal response and poetry.

Mathematics

- We are learning to investigate the value of fractions and compare them by converting to equivalent fractions with common denominators.
- We are learning the base ten place value system can be extended to decimals (tenths, hundredths and thousandths)
- We are learning to add and subtract decimal numbers.
- We are learning that theoretical probability can be calculated, placed on a numerical scale and compared to actual outcomes of chance experiments.

Inquiry

- We are learning to investigate community resources and strategies for seeking help about health, safety, and wellbeing.
- We are learning to research to build on our knowledge and understanding of the history of Federation in Australia.
- We are learning to identify influential people who contributed to the Australian Federation.
