DEAR PARISHIONERS, We are pleased to be able to gather once again for the Eucharist and prayer under the guidelines of the Chief Health Office.

We ask that you kindly use the QR code provided which indicates your attendance and validates your vaccination status. If you do not have a mobile phone, please sign in providing your name, contact details and signing the verification of your vaccination status.

We begin celebrating Masses at St Agatha's this week for 20 fully vaccinated parishioners from Monday 25th October.

From this Thursday evening Mass at 7.00 pm and from next weekend the 10.45 am Mass on Sunday will be celebrated for 10 people with an unknown vaccination status and for those who are unable to be vaccinated. All other weekend Masses are for fully vaccinated only. We thank you for your respectful care of your sisters and brothers in faith

The Adoration will remain closed for renovations until further notice. Baptism ceremonies will resume on Sunday 7th November for 7 families, please contact the office to book or for more information.

Baptism Preparation will be held on Sunday the 7th November at 3.00pm in the Church, if you have any questions please contact the parish office.

First Communion ceremonies will be celebrated on Sunday 21st & 28th November and 5th December at 2.00 pm. A link will be available to families for online bookings. For those who are unable to attend these ceremonies, First Communion ceremonies will be held during weekend Masses over the first 3 weekends in December.

RE Classes are suspended for now until further notice.

Extraordinary Ministers and Lector Rosters will be available in November.
