2. Damian: School Update:

- Termination of Camp Australia relationship, to cease at end of Term 3.
 - Several care providers shortlisted, with Their Care a front runner.
- Student Wellbeing Survey results and feedback
 - Student wellbeing survey (Years 3-6) results were lower than expected.
 - Need to consider how we communicate wellbeing topics to parents, recognising the importance of the school/parent partnership to support students.
 - Student Representative Council (SRC) to be engaged around wellbeing initiatives.
 - Trusted adult available to all students
 - As part of a broader plan, SEB discussed introducing a 'Parent Buddy' system for new parents to the school.
 - Damian to send out topline survey results to SEB to identify two items within the survey and provide feedback/improvement ideas before next meeting.

3. Shane Giese - Maths

- Essential Assessments demonstration.
- Q: Frequency of testing? A: Varies, depending on the length of the unit.
- Propose a move to online testing. Snapshot only, not for everyday use.
- Will provide better use of time for teachers. More time available for teaching rather than data gathering.
- Child login, shared parent activity. Unlike Mathletics, Essential Assessments would deliver content to students to work on at home, pitched at their specific capabilities and extending them when necessary.
- To be decided, should Pre tests be different to Post tests?


