

# Micro-credentials week offering 2021

Baking for the holidays	In the kitchen, students will bake shortbread and decorate their cookies in Christmas themes.
Beginner Guitar	In the band room, students will learn basic guitar skills from an external provider.
Bike maintenance	Students will learn to service, repair, and maintain their bike with an external provider. Students will need to provide their own bike for this session.
Building Beaumaris	In the workshop students will make a 3d topographical map of Beaumaris to develop their woodwork and laser cutting skills.
Cheer and Chant	In the gym, students will learn basic cheer manoeuvres and create rousing chants.
Citizen science	Students will participate in the Backyard Bird count by identifying and documenting bird life around the school.
CPR and First Aid	Students will learn basic first aid and be certified to provide CPR in medical emergencies.
Drumming workshop	In the band room, students will learn basic drumming skills and creative rhythms.
Footprints of Beaumaris	Students will calculate their impact on the environment. They will investigate the impact of the school, the Beaumaris community, and the country.
Gingerbread houses	In this 3 session activity students will bake, build, and decorate their gingerbread houses. Students will attend 3 2-hour sessions throughout the week.
Hair styling workshop	Students will learn how to create stylish up-do's and braids.
Jam session	In the band room, students will use various instruments to play music of their choice.
Learning environment set up	Students will work in all areas of the school to optimise the learning environment for 2022.
Maths in review	Students will review core learning of their choice to build understanding and be prepared for next year. Students will have the opportunity to extend their mathematical understanding beyond core learning.
Mixed martial arts	Students will learn basic mixed martial arts and learn how to de-escalate situations to avoid conflict from an external provider.
Musical theatre	In the drama studio, students will learn musical theatre skills and learn a new performance piece. Students will attend 2 2-hour sessions throughout the week.
Origami and sushi making	Students will learn the art of origami and sushi making inspired by their Japanese language lessons
Photography	Students will use school DSLR cameras to capture moments and learn new editing techniques.
Pottery	In the art room, students will use clay and hand modelling techniques to make a piece of their choice. Students will attend 2 2-hour sessions throughout the week.

Screen printing	In the art room, students will learn design and screen-printing techniques to create a unique art piece for a bag or t-shirt. Students will attend 2 2-hour sessions throughout the week. Students need to provide their own cotton bag or t-shirt for this activity.
Shakespeare's Macbeth workshop	In the drama studio, students will study and perform pieces from Macbeth. Students will attend 2 2-hour sessions throughout the week.
Shoot to show	Students will use school DSLR cameras to create a short film and learn new editing techniques. Students will attend 2 2-hour sessions throughout the week.
Study supervision	Students will catch up on any missed learning or complete additional learning to be prepared for next year.
Team games	Students will compete in large team games such as dodge ball in a short round robin style competition.
World of sport	Students will learn how to play a variety of cultural sports from around the world.
Writing workshop	Students will stretch their creative writing skills using prompts and learning new language conventions through collaboration.
