Dear Families,

This year the Parents Association is organising our School Colour Run. Weather permitting, the Colour Run will be held on Friday November 14 from 2pm – 3:15pm on the school oval. Below is a summary of the details of the Colour Run.

- 1. Every child is invited to participate in the Colour Run. If your child does not want colour powder on them please indicate that on your permission form and they will wear a sash to indicate to parents and staff not to spray them with the powder.
- 2. Every child is issued with the coloured sponsor form attached, please ask family and close friends to sponsor your child either per lap or a general donation. Children will be walking/running around the oval. Every dollar raised will be going towards the fundraising of a new sensory/imaginary playspace near the hall.
- 3. Sponsor sheets can be completed on the <u>Trybooking</u> or returned to the classroom teacher on Monday 24 November with cash donations. Extra cards will be available from the office, if you fill one up and need more room. Prizes up for grabs for biggest fundraisers of each year level.
- 4. Children need to wear a white t-shirt and any coloured shorts for the **whole day**. Please note we are using 100% Natural, Gluten Free Powder which should come out in the wash but old clothes are recommended. It would be ideal to bring a towel and change of clothes in the car at pick up. Eye wear is highly recommended and available for purchase using <a href="Trybooking">Trybooking</a>. Students are to bring their own drink bottles and will receive a Zooper Dooper at the conclusion of the Colour Run.
- 5. Colour Run Cards with the number of laps will be returned to the children the day of the Colour Run. Children will then proceed to collect monies and return it before Monday 24 November.
- 6. We are looking for Parent Volunteers on the day to help set up, pack up and facilitate the colour run with us. If you are able to help please sign up with the Volunteer Sign Up sheet shared on your level's Whatsapp Group.

The school Colour Run should prove to be a lot of fun. Parents are especially encouraged to come along, and cheer on their children.
