INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. If you are absent from an examination due to illness or injury that prevents you from attending or completing an examination, you must contact the College as soon as possible. **Please note that a medical certificate is required for an absence from an examination.**

2. Students are only required to attend school for their exams. If students have two exams on the same day, they are encouraged to leave school after their morning exam and ensure that they are on time for their afternoon exam. Alternatively, a venue will be made available to study at school in between morning and afternoon exams. These venue should be used for exam study and students are expected to maintain a high level of behaviour.
3. Candidates should aim to arrive **twenty (20) minutes** before the commencement of the examination and are not required to attend Homeroom.
4. Students must keep all their bags, mobile phones and watches in their lockers. Any student with a mobile phone must turn the phone off and place it in the box provided on the supervisor's desk.
5. Candidates that intend to make use of their **Purple Card** must inform the **Coordinator of Learning Support, Mrs Bridget Kamazizwa** in the week prior to the examination. Please email purplecard@norbert.wa.edu.au. Please present your Purple Card in the Examination venue.
6. Candidates MUST attend the examination wearing the **College (Winter) Uniform**. A student may be excluded from the Examination if they choose not to adhere to College expectations for uniform and personal presentation.
7. Ensure that all drinks are in **clear plastic bottles** with all labels removed. Only water is allowed in drink bottles.
8. Please check the schedule to ensure you attend the correct examination venue.
9. Candidates must ensure that they attend their examination with all necessary materials, and are to note the following:
 - Approved materials (I.e.: calculators & notes) for Mathematics examinations must be confirmed with the Head of Mathematics.
 - Mathematics notes are not to be folded, creased or glued together.
 - A student is ***typically*** permitted two A4 (doubled sided) sheets as a maximum.

10. Use of the toilet:

- Toilet visits are not a right and should ONLY be used as an emergency. Students are encouraged to go to the toilet prior to entering the examination venue.

11. When *Reading Time* commences, candidates are not permitted to conduct any writing or marking of the exam paper(s). At the conclusion of *Reading Time*, candidates will be informed that their *Working Time* has commenced.
