Wishing all students and their families an enjoyable mid year holiday ahead.


Things to remember:

Term 2 Reflection

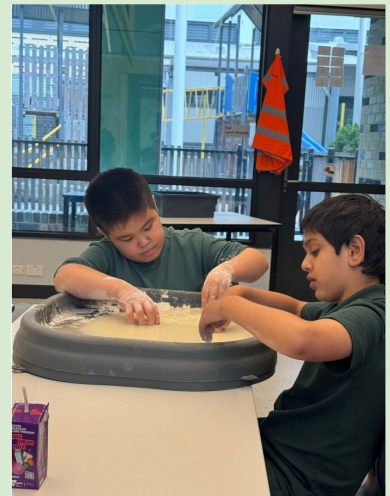
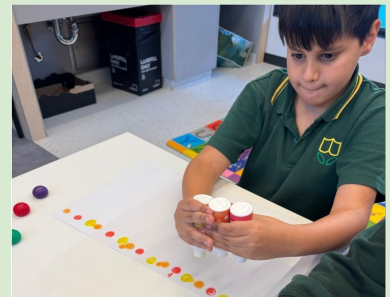

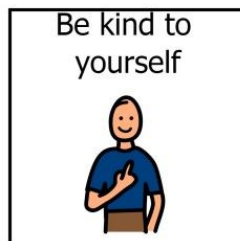
