Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parents Council (TCSPC)

Nominations for the position of School/College Nominee to the Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parents Council for a two (2) year term are being sought.

Nominations are sought from persons who are committed to Catholic education and believe they could make a contribution to the spirit, development and growth of Catholic Education in Tasmania as School/College Nominee of the Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parent Council.

Nominees shall preferably have an association with Catholic education, eg their child(ren)'s education in a Tasmanian Catholic School/College; participation in a school/college Parents and Friends Association or community; membership on school/college Boards, or similar.

Each School/College Principal, Parents and Friends Association Executive and Board Executive can work in conjunction with each other to select a single nominee. The nominees details are to be completed on the Nomination Form and emailed to the Executive Officer of the TCSPC. don.ryan@aohtas.org.au

The School/College Nominees shall be appointed for a period of two (2) years and may be reappointed for two (2) subsequent terms (Maximum of six (6) years served consecutively). There is also the opportunity to nominate to be on the Executive Committee of the TCSPC.

There are 3 after hours Council meetings per year that members are requested to attend, one of which is held at the same time as the AGM.

To ensure the Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parents Council remains responsive to the needs of parents and carers in Tasmanian Catholic schools, the Nominee will keep the School/College Community informed of the activities of the Council through the provision of updates to their Catholic School/College Parents and Friends Association, Boards and Principal. The Nominees will be the link between the Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parents Council and Tasmanian Catholic Schools/Colleges.

The person nominated will be recommended to the Archbishop for appointment. The school/college nominee may attend TCSPC meetings prior to their formal appointment being confirmed by the Archbishop.
