about a series of road improvement projects currently being planned to address safety and traffic flow along Wingham Road, between Cedar Party Road and Kolodong Road.

Commencing later this year, these works along a busy section of Wingham Road are part of our commitment to improving the roads that connect our community.

Join us to find out more about three segments being targeted in a staged approach:

- Stage 1 - In this stage, we'll focus on the segment between Clifton Road, through to just west of Hargreaves Drive, as well as replacing the existing utilities in the stage two area. The work will be undertaken towards the end of 2019, and involves rehabilitation of the existing road pavement to provide a smoother and safer travel route.
- Stage 2 - Scheduled to take place early in the 2020/21 financial year, this major reconstruction project includes rehabilitation of the existing road and introducing a series of improvements including formalised turning lanes at Cedar Party Road and at Potoroo Drive, realignment of Hargreaves Drive with Marie Avenue, and also a roundabout at this intersection. As well as targeting improved safety, the design aims to assist traffic flow and minimise build-up during peak periods.
- Stage 3 - This stage is yet to be scheduled, however we're currently reviewing design options for traffic management at the intersection of Kolodong Road.
