OnTrack Flex offers a flexible delivery mode of units for a full time or part time study load delivered on campus and online. A combination of units allows students to shape their learning in an area of study they are passionate to pursue whilst preparing them for their desired undergraduate degree. You will be assisted to explore an undergraduate degree program that matches your aspirations and have access to a network of peer, academic and professional support at the University.

## Course structure

Students will complete 4 units over 1 semester (full time) or a part time equivalent.

A combination of units allows students to shape their learning in an area of study they are passionate to pursue whilst preparing them for their desired undergraduate degree.

Students will study 2 required units, 1 specified elective and 1 broad disciplinary unit. We recommend students choose a broad disciplinary unit that is related to their preferred undergraduate course at Murdoch.

## Contact hours

### On campus studies

For units delivered on campus, students will need to dedicate approximately 10 hours of study per week to each unit they are enrolled in. This includes attending lectures, workshops, tutorials, and further independent study. Additional workshops and support are also provided to build skills. Student timetables will vary depending on units studied and enrolled campus.

### Online studies

For units delivered online, students will need to dedicate approximately 10 hours of study per week to each unit they are enrolled in. This includes watching lectures, attending online workshops and further independent study. Additional workshops and support are also provided to build skills.

Studying 4 units at one time (online or on campus) requires an investment of approximately 40 hours per week. Students should consider enrolling part-time if they cannot meet this time commitment.

## Entry Requirements

### Are you:

- An Australian/New Zealand citizen or the holder of an Australian permanent residency or humanitarian visa
- Aged at least 17 years and 6 months by 1 January of the year commencing OnTrack Flex.

### Have you achieved one of the following?

- Completed year 11 and 12 in Australia
- Completed any Cert III or a Cert II in General Education for Adults
- I do not qualify for direct entry to Murdoch University but can demonstrate preparedness to study via the Readiness Evaluation Test.
