- **ANZAC Day Service:** bringing together 500+ primary school students each April to honour those who served
- **Men's Hub Snack & Chat:** a welcoming weekly space for men 18+ to connect and enjoy fellowship
- **Knox infolink:** supporting locals experiencing hardship through breakfast and practical assistance
- **Knox Community Garden Plot:** providing fresh produce for Knox infolink customers

### Supporting young people

Programs that build skills, confidence, leadership and belonging.

- **Youth Skills Shed:** award-winning hands-on program teaching practical trade skills with local schools
