<p>Write a persuasive text on a topic of your choice. Include at least three arguments to support your opinion.</p>	<p>Create a weekly budget for yourself. Include income (e.g., allowance, chores) and expenses (e.g., snacks, toys). Make sure it balances.</p>	<p>Find and read an article about the 2024 Olympics. Write a news report summarizing the key events, highlighting the achievements of athletes, and reflecting on the impact of the Olympics on the host city.</p>
<p>Write a short story (1-2 pages) about an adventure in a magical land. Use descriptive language and dialogue.</p>	<p>Select a spelling word and dive into its origin, uncovering its linguistic roots and evolution. Identify related words in its family, dissecting any prefixes or suffixes to understand their meanings.</p>	<p>Keep a daily or weekly journal documenting your thoughts, experiences, and reflections on events happening in your life or in the world around you.</p>
