

We play with sticks safely, following the stick play rules.

We love playing with sticks!

## We don't

throw sticks or rocks
or
swing sticks around
or
use sticks as weapons
(even pretend weapons)

Sticks are for everyone to use.

## You will need to compromise when playing with sticks.

You might need to find a different stick or do rock paper scissors.

If a stick looks like it is part of a cubby, it is probably part of a cubby! Find another stick.

If a stick is lying on the ground away from a cubby, it is probably free to take!

If a stick is neatly cut, it is a garden stake or part of the Moth of Good Hope and not for cubbies

We do not play with sticks on the oval or in the out of bounds areas.

If you have a stick problem, practice your problem solving skills.

If you can't solve it, ask an adult to help.

Sticks stay outside.

If a stick is longer than your arm, one end must stay on the ground.
