AUTHENTICITY - RESPECT - CONNECTION - CREATIVITY

**We play with sticks safely,
following the stick play rules.**

**We love
playing with
sticks!**

We don't
throw sticks or rocks
or
swing sticks around
or
use sticks as weapons
(even pretend weapons)

**Sticks are for everyone to
use.**

**You will need to
compromise when playing
with sticks.**

You might need to find a different stick or do
rock paper scissors.

**If a stick looks like it is part of a cubby, it is
probably part of a cubby! Find another stick.**

If a stick is neatly
cut, it is a garden
stake or part of the
Moth of Good Hope
and not for cubbies

**If a stick is lying on the ground away from a cubby,
it is probably free to take!**

**We do not play with sticks on the
oval or in the out of bounds areas.**

Sticks stay outside.

If you have a stick problem, practice
your problem solving skills.
If you can't solve it, ask an adult to
help.

**If a stick is longer than
your arm, one end must
stay on the ground.**
