- Attract increased parent involvement in key areas of curriculum.
 Measure: Increased involvement of all stakeholders in school events & activities. Retention of students through to Grade 6.
- Provide recommendations and/or introductions to external organisations and businesses that will build financial, reputational and social capital.
 Measure: Community involvement, endorsement & delivery of Masterplan within timeframes and budgeted expenditure.
- Assist the Principal and School Leadership with the development & review of all School Policies & Procedures.

Measure: Introduction of a comprehensive set of policies and supporting procedures that are readily available, widely understood and comply with the requirements of the Government & Catholic Education Office.

- Provide feedback and advice; as required by the Principal and School Leadership; on curriculum, extracurricular activities, results and promotion of the School for incoming and outgoing students & their families. Measure: Enrolment demand improves, student retention through to Grade 6, student placement at their secondary school of choice.
- Review the School Education Board's Constitution to ensure our purpose, roles and responsibilities are understood by each SEB Member and the broader School Community.
 Measure: Charter is up to date and in line with sound governance principles. Board members are appropriately trained / educated as to their roles and responsibilities as a SEB member.
