Start your career with a School-Based Traineeship

School-based apprenticeships and traineeships (SBAT) are a great way to set yourself up for your future career, while completing your HSC.

SBAT courses combine paid work, training and school and are available to high school students in NSW who are in Years 10, 11, and 12.

You could:

Round 1 Closes 28 September

If you didn't quite get the required ATAR, you can apply for entry into one of our undergraduate degrees with a portfolio that shows your design skills and creativity.

The portfolio submission is a potential way for you to gain entry into our programs if you achieved close to the required ATAR (or equivalent). In conjunction with the HSC and other formal assessment systems, it assists the University to identify students with the potential to excel in architecture or design computing.

If you are expecting to receive an ATAR of up to five points lower than or roughly around the ATAR for your preferred course, we encourage you to apply by submitting a portfolio.

How do I Become a Bricklaying Apprentice?



If you are interested in learning how to become a bricklayer in Australia then we recommend following these steps:

- 1. Find an Employer: ABBTF will help place you with an employer who is willing to take on an apprentice.
- 2. Choose a Training Provider: your on-site training will be provided by a TAFE or a RTO.
- 3. Stay Focused: You'll spend the next 3-4 years training as an apprentice with your employer.

When you complete your apprenticeship you'll be a qualified Bricklayer/Blocklayer.


