

College Carpark Expectations



The dot points below outline several processes involving the College carpark which keeps our children safe, ease congestion and keeps traffic moving. Drop-off and pick-up times can be very busy, and we appreciate your patience at those peak times.

- **Please follow the arrows, park only in the marked bays** with the vehicle's nose facing in, or collect passengers from the drop off zone/s.
- When entering the **South Campus** gate, **only go straight ahead**. There is no right turn.
- When you enter the **North Campus** gate, **only go left**. There is no access to the TSC.
- **Students may only be collected from in front of B-Block, A-Block or N Block**. Students are not permitted to wait for pick-up on the pedestrian islands. These areas are checked regularly, and students will be asked to return to the correct waiting zones.
- Students must only enter or exit a vehicle parked in a marked bay or at the kerb in the drop-off zones. **Please do NOT allow children to enter or exit a vehicle in the flow of traffic**.
- To come to the **South campus drop off zone, please join the queue through the staff car park turn-around area**. Please do not exit against the arrows. Other vehicles are waiting to enter.
- **Keep moving as far forward as possible in the drop-off zones** to allow more vehicles to collect/alight their passengers behind you.
- **Drivers must stay in the vehicle in the drop-off zones**. Vehicles should not be left unattended in the drop-off zones. Park in a carpark if you wish to get out to collect or assist children.
- **Please do not pull in front of other vehicles in the drop-off zones**. It will only take a few minutes in the queue.
- **Only use the crossings to cross the carpark**. Model correct procedures for your children.
- **Designated Accessible Parking** - Do not park in these spaces unless drivers or passengers in your vehicle hold a valid Australian Disability Parking (ADP) Permit or an equivalent recognised accessible parking permit. The permit must be clearly displayed in the vehicle, and the permit holder must be traveling in the car as either a driver or a passenger at the time of use.
- If you have children on both North and South campuses, **please arrange for collection of all children from one campus only (North or South)**. Please do not cross between campuses during the morning or afternoon peak periods.
- Please be reminded that there are **no staff on duty until 8:35 am**. We request that you avoid dropping your children off before this time.

Please also note that the grassed area to the left of the entrance to South Campus is council land and should not be used for parking. If council officers attend, parking in this area may be subject to fines.
