The College has organised for Elective Drama students in Yrs 10 & 11 to watch Sport for Jove's production of *The Crucible* at Seymour Centre. *The Crucible* by American playwright Arthur Miller is one of the defining plays of the twentieth century.

This classic parable of mass hysteria draws a chilling parallel between the Salem witch-hunt of 1692 - 'one of the strangest and most awful chapters in human history' - and the McCarthyism which gripped America in the 1950s. The story of how the small community of Salem is stirred into madness by superstition, paranoia and malice, culminating in a violent climax, is a savage attack on the evils of mindless persecution and the terrifying power of false accusations.
