



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – 2025 SKILL SETS

Who is eligible to apply for a Skill Set Program?

Skill Set programs are only available for students who are in Year 11 & Year 12. These are not available for students in Year 10. Skills Set programs are also not suitable for students who are in an Education Support School.

Is my student eligible if they are already completing a VETDSS Course?

Yes! VETDSS students are funded for the following:

- Two full qualifications from the VETDSS funded list **OR**
- One full qualification and one Skill Set from the VETDSS funded list

Can a student apply for more than one Skill Set program?

Yes. However, students can only be funded for one full qualification and one Skill Set.

Is there work placement involved with a Skill Set?

Depending on what Skill Set program you apply for, there may be work placement hours, please refer to the program flyer for this information.

If a student has completed two full qualifications under the VETDSS funded list, is he/she eligible to apply and enrol for a Skill Set?
