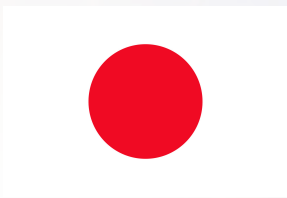

Culture	Tokyo travel and sightseeing, theme parks / cultural attractions, Mountain activities.
Transport & Accommodation	Flights Brisbane: Tokyo return, bus transport Tokyo sightseeing. Tokyo to ski location & return. Ski field accommodation, Twin, 3, 4 share. Tokyo accommodation
Who & Numbers	Current Year 9, 10 & 11 students The trip can accommodate 30 students
Cost	This trip will cost approximately \$6500 - \$8000. **International travel expenses have risen considerably**

How do I get on the trip?

1. Collect Expression of Interest form from Mr Maclean at the sports hall office
2. Discuss with parents / carers & sign form
 - a)By signing you and parents are agreeing to the trip and payment plan
3. Return to Mr Maclean
4. Names will go on a list in order of return
 - a)Students over the maximum are placed on a waitlist
5. School confirms the trip & final price + payment schedule
6. Students on the list are invoiced for the deposit payment
 - a)Paying the deposit secures the place on the trip
 - b)Students who do not pay the deposit by the due date are replaced by students on the wait list.
