
The Chickens Project at Mercy Orphanage and School in Kenya is an ongoing project that fits in during the quieter times of the agricultural year.



It began in response to food insecurity during COVID-19, supporting community families with training and resources in organic gardening. Pictured below are families receiving chickens as part of the initial training.

As a next step in the Chicken's Project, we want to aid the *construction of a chicken house and feed mill* to make their own chicken feed. The community found that chicken feed from the local markets was of poor quality. Secondly, they want to achieve more protection of chickens from predators

and maximise the use of the manure for the gardens. This will create employment for staff to run the mill and the chicken house.





Building costs are approximately \$4,500 with the Feed Mill machinery to produce quality chicken feed approximately \$3,580.

Our strategy is to start collecting cans and bottles for recycling to help finance this project.
