If planning to play both Junior competitions and Senior competitions, you must register with both programs (i.e. twice).

Things you will need to register:

- MyCricket ID number or create a new profile to generate an ID number
- Online payment for the Junior program – reimbursed upon season commencement

Players must be registered for insurance purposes.

Players must be registered to appear on MyCricket. This allows for team selections and player statistics tracking across the season.
