Upcoming night works and lane closures at Deer Park in September

We're removing the level crossing at Mt Derrimut Road by elevating the rail line over the road to reduce congestion. We're also building a new Deer Park Station and creating a safer, better connected Deer Park.

With major works now underway, we'll continue to excavate and drill deep holes into the ground near the station to prepare foundations for the elevated rail bridge until November 2022.

In September and early October, we'll also:

- pour concrete to form supports for the new rail bridge
- relocate and replace underground utilities on Station Road, Tilburn Road and in the rail corridor (lane closures will be in place)
- continue to build retaining walls near Tilburn Road and Railway Parade/Railway Parade South
- commence works on the new commuter car park south of the rail line
- set up new site facilities on Railway Parade South (near Bon Thomas Reserve) and beside Tilburn Road
- deliver and install large beams at the site of the new Deer Park Station

Upcoming night works

At times, we'll work at night to minimise disruption to traffic. We'll work overnight from **7pm to 6am**:

- **Sunday 4 September:** line marking and concrete barrier installation on Station Road for upcoming road works
- **Tuesday 13 September:** relocating site monitoring equipment in the rail corridor near Deer Park Station
- **Thursday 15 to Friday 23 September and Friday 30 September to Friday 7 October:** relocating underground utilities at Station and Tilburn roads
- **Wednesday 5 to Sunday 9 October:** deliver and install large concrete beams at the site of the new station

We'll also work 24 hours a day, 5 days a week from **Monday 12 September to mid October 2022** to build the large concrete bridge supports near Deer Park Station. Night works are not currently planned on Friday and Saturday nights.

There may be other times we'll need to work overnight, impacted residents will be contacted in advance.

What to expect

As works progress, you may notice medium to high levels of noise during the day, with some dust and vibration. You may also notice an increase in construction vehicles moving to and from the works areas. When we work at night, additional lighting will be in place for worker safety, lighting will be directed away from residential properties where possible.

Changes to the way you travel

Ongoing lane closures will be in place at times on Station Road, Tilburn Road, Railway Parade/South and Mt Derrimut Road. Motorist and pedestrian detours will be in place. Traffic management and signage will help guide you through the area.
