Release of ATAR rescheduled to January 2022

On 27 August 2021, the NSW Government announced that HSC written exams will now start on 9 November 2021 and HSC results will be released in mid-January 2022. UAC is working closely with NESA and universities to finalise arrangements for the calculation and release of the ATAR in January 2022 and the release of offers based on ATAR in January and February 2022.

ATAT Q&A. What Next?



January is just another month in the summer break for current tertiary students, but for recent school leavers it means one thing — <u>university offers</u>. If you're one of the many students nervously waiting for offer day, check out our <u>Q&A</u> below.

The ATAR is a rank, not a mark.

The Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) is a number between 0.00 and 99.95 that indicates a student's position relative to all the students in their age group (ie all 16 to 20 year olds in NSW). So, an ATAR of 80.00 means that you are 20 per cent from the top of your age group (not your Year 12 group). Universities use the ATAR to help them select students for their courses and admission to most tertiary courses is based on your selection rank (your ATAR + any applicable adjustments). Most universities also use other criteria when selecting students (eg a personal statement, a questionnaire, a portfolio of work, an audition, an interview or a test). The average ATAR is usually around 70.00. If every school student went on to achieve an ATAR, the average ATAR would be 50.00. But because some students leave school early and the ones who stay on to receive an ATAR are a smaller, more academically able group, the average ATAR is higher. https://www.uac.edu.au/future-applicants/atar

This will not negatively impact their application.

 To avoid disruption of the written HSC exams the Interview notification date has moved to 12th
 November, and the video submission deadline to 19th
 November.

Schools Assessment Page (SAP)

- Step 1: If you are unable to estimate a class position and/or ATAR for a student, this can be left blank as this step is not compulsory for 2022 applications. If not completed please ensure you enter an academic comment in Step 3.
- Step 3: If unable to complete Step 1 an ATAR range or comment on the student's academic ability can be entered here, as well as any additional comments on the Student's achievements. Schools can upload a document if they wish.
- The due date for the SAP has been extended until Friday 15 October so that any available trial results for a student can be taken into consideration.





The artwork should address this year's theme of Plant the Seed. The subject matter of the art can center around different aspects of this theme. It could focus on the benefits of creating a rain garden to protect a watershed, a community garden to support an urban area, or regenerative farming to improve both water quality and climate change. One could also apply the theme to the planting of a tree as a means to combat the effects of deforestation, increase CO2 capture or habitat security for wildlife. The idea that planting seeds for a garden promotes the health of pollinator populations could also fit into this concept. The theme could also be interpreted more figuratively to imply that like planting a seed, taking an action in connection to any environmental problem can grow into sustainable solutions. These are just a few ideas and should no way limit the artist into how the theme can be represented.




