

INFORMATION PAGE SECONDARY BURSARY GRANTS - YEAR 2026

Purpose:

Financial assistance provided to parents of secondary school pupils attending an Armidale Diocesan Systemic Catholic school, by the Armidale Catholic Schools.

The grants are allocated on a needs basis, measured by the parent's/guardian's family income.

Student Eligibility:

Applicants for the 2026 bursaries should be enrolling in Year 7 in 2026. The assistance continues until the student completes Year 12 or leaves the school. Applications may be submitted for students commencing in years other than Year 7, but priority is given to those applying for Year 7.

Making Application:

Application forms for pupils are currently available through your Catholic secondary school. Applications close for Round 1 on 28th November, 2025. Applications will be accepted after this date if there are unallocated bursaries. Applications may be submitted to the school or directly with Armidale Catholic Schools.

No Need to Re-apply:

It will not be necessary to re-apply for Years 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 if your child has been granted a bursary previously. Continuing bursary holders may be contacted by the Armidale Catholic Schools and asked to submit a copy of their current tax assessment notice.

Income Limit:

Applicants will be eligible to apply if their family income (where there is one child), for the year ended 30th June, 2025 did not exceed **\$75,000**. For families with more than one child, this limit is increased by **\$2,500** for each additional dependent child at school.

That is,

- for families with **1** child the limit is **\$75,000**
- for families with **2** children the limit is **\$77,500**
- for families with **3** children the limit is **\$80,000**
- for families with **4** children the limit is **\$82,500**
- for families with **5** children the limit is **\$85,000**.
- for families with **6** children the limit is **\$87,500**

This limit will be subject to review.

Method of Award:

It is emphasised that although applications will be accepted from families who meet the income criteria, Armidale Catholic Schools will award its bursaries by commencing with the applicants in the greatest need. This sequence will be continued until the quota for bursaries is exhausted. This may well mean that some families whose income is below the threshold may not receive Bursaries.

Conditions:

Bursaries are available to pupils whose parents/guardians are ordinarily permanent residents of this Diocese and who have been subject to Australian Taxation Office rules for the whole of the previous financial year.

Applicants are required to submit a copy of their tax assessment advice for the year ended June 30, 2025, as well as the completed application form. If a tax assessment notice is not applicable, other documentation such as Centrelink statements will be required as proof of income.

Although a pupil may hold only one bursary at a time, other pupils in the same family may also hold bursaries.

Students who are awarded a bursary must attend school regularly and maintain a satisfactory record of progress and conduct.

Bursary Payments:

The bursary will be paid by Armidale Catholic Schools directly to the school that the pupil is attending. In 2026, the amount of the bursary will be \$815, which includes an increase for CPI.

Confidentiality:

All information supplied to Armidale Catholic Schools will be treated with the strictest confidentiality.
