#### **ACU Guarantee**

#### Opens - 1 June Closes - early October

Guarantee your place at ACU, even before your Year 12 exams. The ACU Guarantee program offers eligible Year 12 students a place at ACU based on your Year 11 results.

Offers may be made as early as July. While successful applicants must still complete their Year 12 exams, you can do so secure in the knowledge that your marks from Year 11 meet our entry requirements. You may also enhance your entry score by including a short personal statement that gives ACU an insight into your personal circumstances and motivation for university study.

By assessing your Year 11 results, we can give you a predicted selection rank and make you an offer before you sit your HSC/VCE/QCE. Of course, your final exams still matter – and you still need to finish Year 12 to validate your offer – but you can tackle them comforted by the fact that you already have a place in your university degree of choice.

Opens – 2 March 2022

Closes – 23 May 2022

30 May 2022 – Deadline to upload your co-curricula & service documents

5 September 2022 – Application offers released Direct applications for study in 2023 are open 2 March 2022

If you apply directly for study in 2023, your application will cover admissions, scholarships and campus accommodation.

Early offers made on 5 September 2022 are based on Year 11 results. ANU will honour these for study in 2023 as long as you complete Year 12 and receive an ATAR.

If your Year 11 results don't meet entry requirements, we will put you on our waiting list and automatically consider your application again based on your Year 12 results in the December/January offer round.



#### University of Canberra SRS

#### SRS Applications close 19 September 2022

If you're a current Year 12 student applying to UC for undergraduate study next year, you could receive an alternative early admission offer under the Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) using criteria other than your ATAR. If you're a current Year 12 student, your school can recommend you for admission to the University of Canberra in advance of receiving your ATAR results, based on your abilities and success to date. Like your main application to UC, Schools Recommendation Scheme applications are also made through <u>UAC</u>.

If you apply for the SRS, your school's rating of your aptitudes will be considered, including your capacity for tertiary study. Applying through the SRS doesn't guarantee you an offer to the University of Canberra, as course quotas and other criteria to be considered. If successful, you'll receive an early offer to UC for your chosen course in November.

To apply for the SRS, the first step is to speak with your school careers adviser to find out how your school is managing SRS applications. Each school can choose how they want to use SRS so it's important you find out about your school's process, selection criteria and timelines before you start.

Once you have familiarised yourself with your school's SRS application process, submit your university application through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC). You'll then be able to use your UAC application number to start your SRS application. UAC's Schools Recommendation Scheme

<u>information</u> gives you detailed instructions on exactly how to apply, what sort of documents you may need and key dates for the UAC part of your SRS application. #### Early Admission **Applications Open 18 July** Applications Close - 12 August 2022

All shortlisted applicants will be advised of their Early Admission outcomes on 10 October 2022, before the NSW HSC exams commence.

UOW Early Admission is our early offer program for students completing Year 12 (Higher School Certificate or other Australian equivalents) during 2022. When you apply for Early Admission, UOW looks beyond your ATAR and considers your unique skills and experiences, alongside your Year 11 results, so you can earn an offer to uni before you sit your first exam. Getting into UOW early means less stress for you at that time and provides you with the certainty that next year you'll be studying at a uni who knows you're more than your ATAR.
