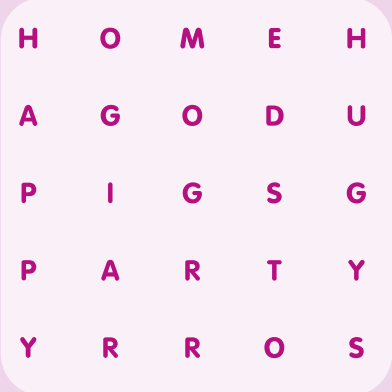
Maze

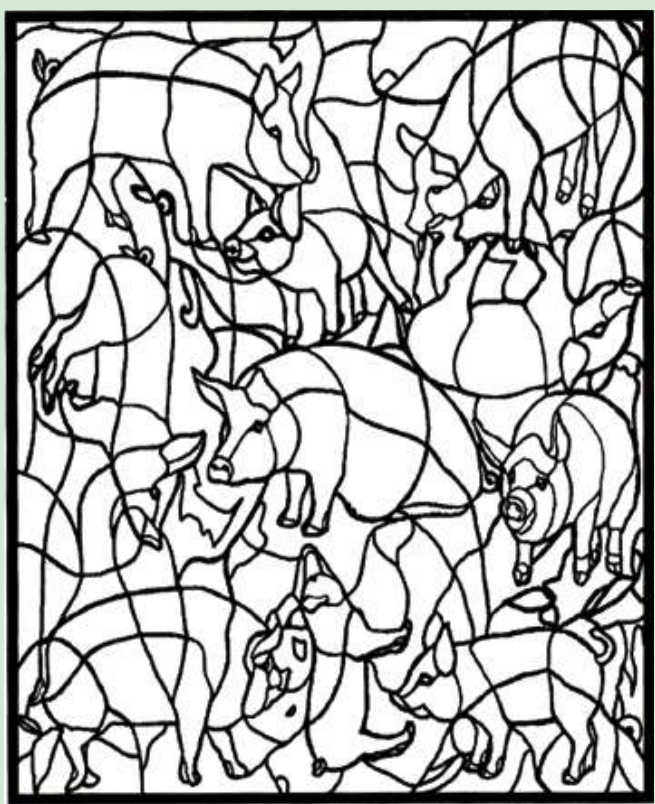
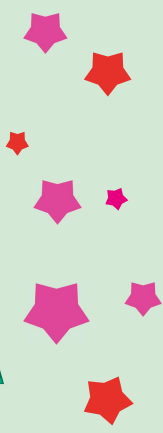
Pack your bag
