

Code of Conduct for Coaches

What you can expect from the Ringwood Swimming Club and its Coaches including paid coaching staff or volunteers, where they are acting as a representative of RSC:

We expect RSC Coaches will:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all individuals in the RSC swimming environment
- **2. Show support and leadership** We are here to help YOU achieve YOUR individual goals and reach your potential, respecting your talent and developmental stage.
- **3.** Be Trustworthy We believe in clarity of communication. Any advice we offer in training and competition will have your emotional, physical and mental wellness best interests in mind.
- **4. Model honesty and fairness:** in all decision making and ensure any decisions impacting swimmer development are made without bias
- **5.** Model Open Mindedness and will not form opinions about choices or lifestyle decisions and shall remain supportive with positive encouragement and feedback in your development
- **6. Be available and approachable** to both parents and swimmers to discuss your goals and strategies to achieve them.
- **7. Be well informed** and have a firm understanding of RSC policies and guidelines which will be at the core of everything we do
- **8.** Be respectful and courteous and will refrain from any form of abuse, intimidation, harassment or discrimination towards swimmer, parent or staff member
- **9. Be child safe focused** and ensure any physical contact with swimmers is appropriate and necessary for swimmer development and in accordance with RSC's Child Safeguarding policy
- **10. Be team players** and actively engage with parents and swimmers and ensure there is mutual support and respect amongst swimmers and coaches
- **11. Be responsible** and ensure that swimmers utilize the venues, facilities and equipment available to them appropriately
