2. Executive Summary

MYP Corporation conducted a School Results Survey with parents of St Pius X College commencing 13 May 2019 and concluding 24 May 2019.

St Pius X College provides educational services to students from 850 families.

Survey responses were received from 535 out of a total of 1716 eligible respondents. This equates to a response rate of 31.2%.

St Pius X College recorded an overall satisfaction score of 81% (4.06 out of 5).

- Best practice areas include: Values + Culture, Leadership + Direction, School Communication, Co-curriculum, Parent Engagement, Pastoral Care/Wellbeing, Teaching Standards, Curriculum.
- Fair to good areas include: General, Reporting, Student Engagement, Resources + Facilities, Student Transition, Learning Environment, Homework, Learning + Extension.

The highest and lowest satisfaction score in each parent segment has been identified as follows:

The response rate to open questions is summarised as follows:

- 13 responses were received to the question: "Other marketing source"
- 334 responses were received to the question: "What do you most like about St Pius X College?"
- 295 responses were received to the question: "What would you most like to see improved at St Pius X College?"

Reviewing and analysing the results of this survey will allow St Pius X College to ascertain whether its current strategies are effective and what the key issues are for parents. This will provide St Pius X College with a clear indication of where to focus efforts in order to improve student attraction, engagement and retention.

3. Background

The following section explains how the survey was conducted, how results were scored and how to best interpret the report.

3.1 Survey Methodology

The survey contained two components: School Strategies and Parent Engagement.

St Pius X College management provided responses to the 'School Strategies' component while parents were asked to provide responses to the 'Parent Engagement' component. (Please refer to the Comprehensive Report for the 'School Strategies' component.)

Information regarding the survey was distributed to parents at St Pius X College detailing how to complete the survey online through MYP Corporation's secure website. To encourage parents to provide honest feedback, this communication outlined the confidentiality of individual responses. In addition, to encourage a high level of participation, regular email reminders were forwarded to parents until they completed the survey or until the survey closing date.

The SRS for St Pius X College contained 35 standard statements and St Pius X College elected to include 10 additional custom statements. All statements had 6 possible responses which were scored as follows:

- Strongly agree (5)
- Agree (4)
- Neutral (3)
- Disagree (2)
- Strongly disagree (1)
- Not applicable (-)

The 'Not applicable' option enabled parents to opt out of responding to a statement that had no applicability to them. 'Not applicable' responses were not included in the calculation of summary results.

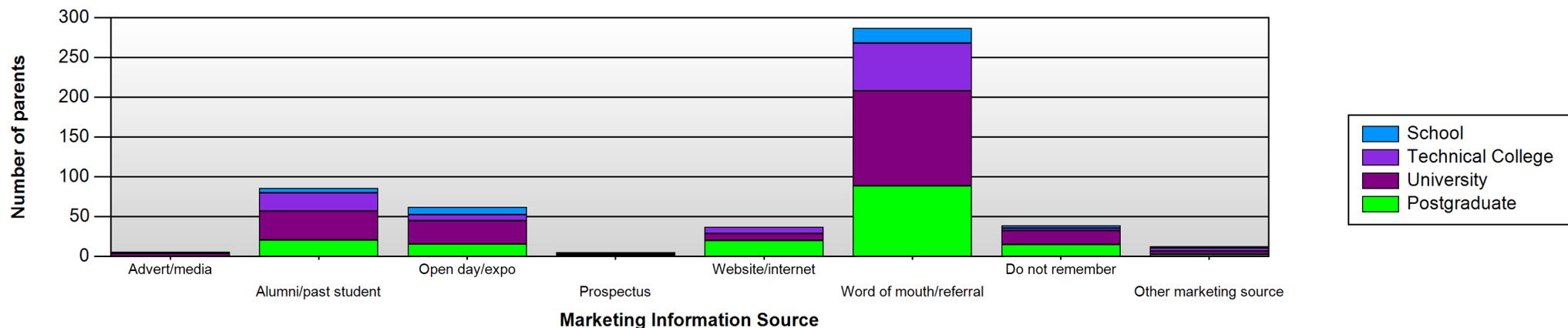

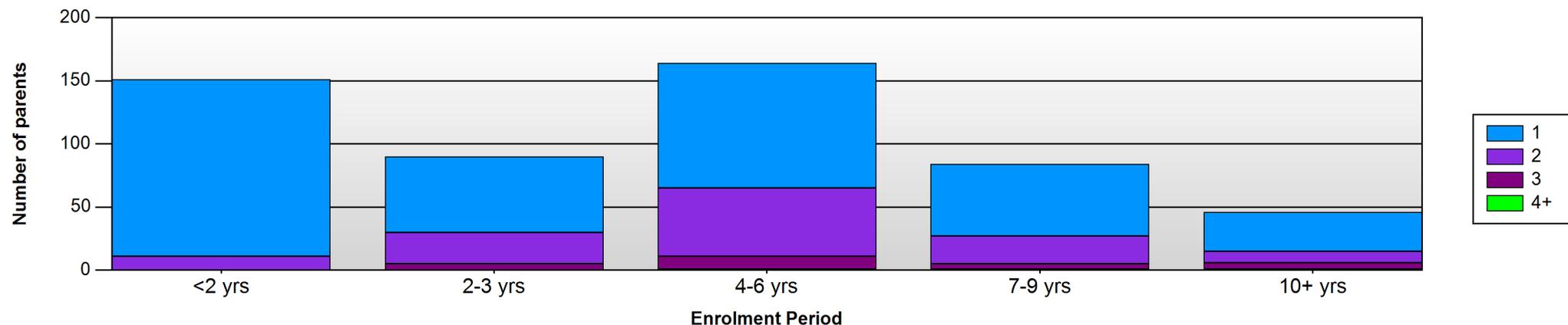

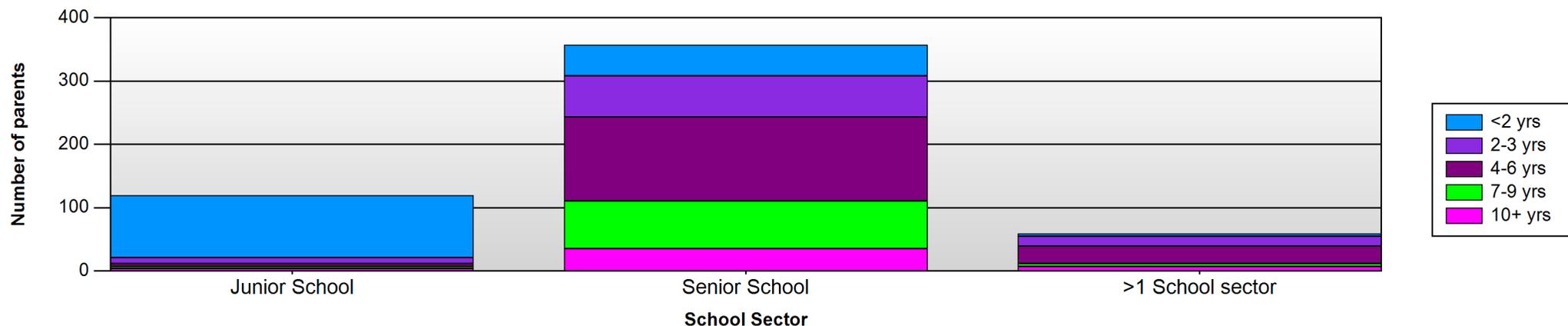

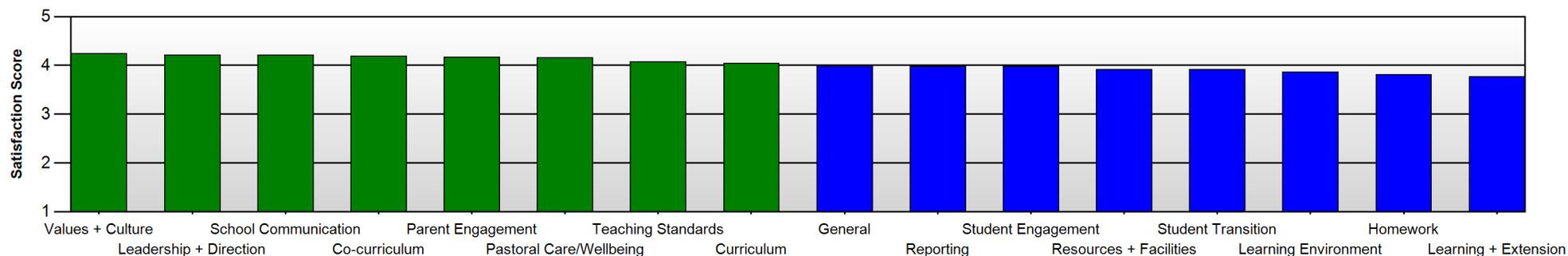

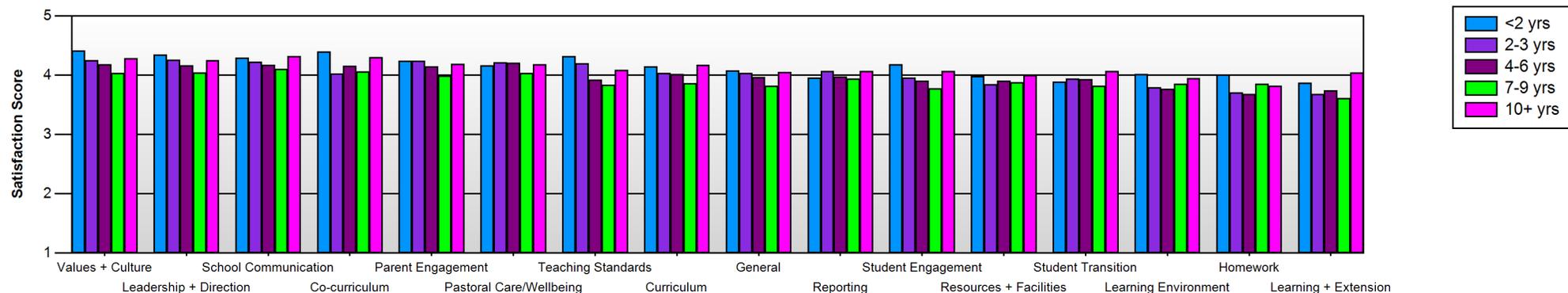
