Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend St Pius X College fixtures if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- · have recently visited locations of identified COVID-19 clusters
