## Your pathway into the University of Notre Dame Australia

UniPath is an alternate entry pathway into the University of Notre Dame Australia. Upon successful completion of the program, the student may secure an offer into many of our undergraduate programs.\*

### Why do UniPath?

- ✓ Get a taste of uni life by studying on our Broadway Campus or at one of our satellite sites in south-west Sydney.
- ✓ Gain essential research, writing, maths and communication skills that will set you up for university-level study.
- ✓ Receive mentoring and career advice to explore future study options.
- ✓ Secure an offer for entry into many undergraduate degrees upon successful completion of the program.\*
- ✓ Commence your undergraduate program in Semester 1 with your peers.
- ✓ Apply your acquired UniPath skills to enhance your Year 12 studies.

\*Arts and Sciences (excluding Psychology), Counselling, Communications and Media, Politics and Journalism, Business, Education (Early Childhood Education, and Primary), and Philosophy and Theology.

### How it works

#### 1. Apply for UniPath

Once your school confirms you have been recommended for UniPath, apply online at [notredame.edu.au/study/pathways/unipath](https://notredame.edu.au/study/pathways/unipath).

#### 2. Study UniPath during Year 11 or 12

You will complete four courses:

- Learning for University
- Research & Academic Writing
- Essential Mathematics
- Communication Skills

Notre Dame, in partnership with your school, has designed the program to fit your school timetable during term or school holidays and to be delivered on a Notre Dame campus or at one of our satellite sites.

#### 3. Fees

Free of charge. UniPath is an Australian Government FEE-FREE Uni Ready (FFUR) program.

#### 4. Continue your studies with Notre Dame Uni

You will be eligible to apply for most undergraduate courses\* at Notre Dame if you successfully pass UniPath and complete your Year 12 studies.
