## 2026 Annual Tuition Fee

I am writing to provide you with details regarding changes to tuition fees for the 2026 academic year. School fees are set in consultation with our Business Manager and guided by MACS financial requirements and modelling across all Catholic schools.

Any decision to adjust tuition fees is made with great care. We consider the needs of our students, our commitment to providing a high-quality education, and the financial pressures families may be experiencing. At the same time, Sacred Heart is facing increased operational costs in several key areas, including WorkCover premiums, Child Safety compliance, risk management, teacher resources and professional learning, as well as higher central system costs (Levies MACS).

Our tuition fees are significantly shaped by State and Federal funding, including the Commonwealth Department of Education's annual assessment of our community's Capacity to Contribute (CTC). School funding is complex, and our Direct Measure of Income (DMI) has risen again in 2025 by two points, which greatly impacts the level of funding we receive and further informs our tuition fee structure.

To ensure we can continue delivering personalised, high-quality learning that supports the academic, social and emotional growth of every student, it is necessary to adjust our fees in 2026.

As a result, Sacred Heart's annual tuition fee will increase by \$200 per child, approximately \$5 per week based on 2025 fees.

### **Fee Statements**

All families will receive their annual school fee account at the beginning of Term 1. Statements will also be issued in week 2 of each Term. Family School Fees, Capital Fees, and Curriculum and Technology Levies are charged for the full year on the first statement. Follow-up statements will be issued at the beginning of Terms 2, 3, and 4, showing the current balance.

Additional charges for non-tuition activities (such as Camps and Swimming) will be billed prior to the activity commencing, with notification provided via the nForma Portal.

Thank you for your understanding and for your ongoing trust and support as we work within MACS fee requirements.

## 2026 SCHOOL FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Sacred Heart offers several payment options to help families meet their school fee obligations

<b>Option 1</b>	<b>Full Fee Payment</b>
Payment can be made in full by <b><u>Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March</u></b>	

<b>Option 2</b>	<b>Payment by Quarterly Instalments</b>
Instalments can be paid via EFTPOS or credit card at the school office any time between 8.45am – 4.00pm Monday to Friday on school days. You can also phone through credit card payments if preferred.	
<b>Instalment One</b>	Friday 13 <sup>th</sup> February
<b>Instalment Two</b>	Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> May
<b>Instalment Three</b>	Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> July
<b>Instalment Four</b>	Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> October

<b>Option 3</b>	<b>Direct Debit</b>
Families are welcome to set up a recurring payment via their own banking facility. Please follow the guideline below to calculate your payment. Alternatively, Direct debit facilities can be set up for families to pay in weekly, fortnightly or monthly instalments via our banking institution, Catholic Development Fund. Families are required to complete the direct debit form (attachment on eForm) to nominate a bank account and return it to the school by the end of the 2025 school year. If this option is preferred for payments for the 2026 school year, payments need to start from Friday 13 <sup>th</sup> February 2026.
