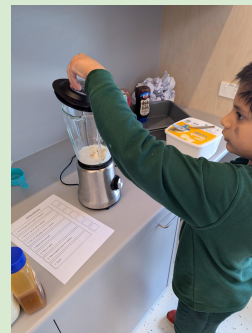
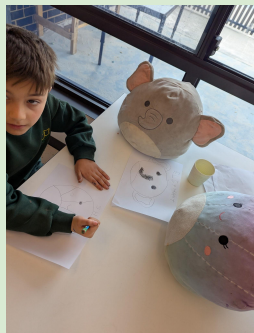



5A Acacia

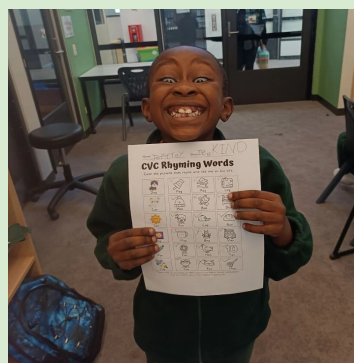
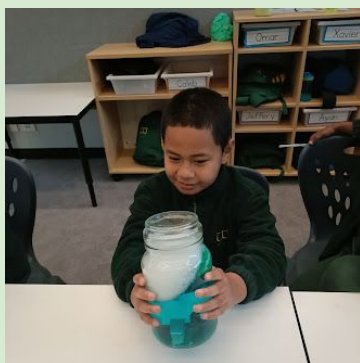
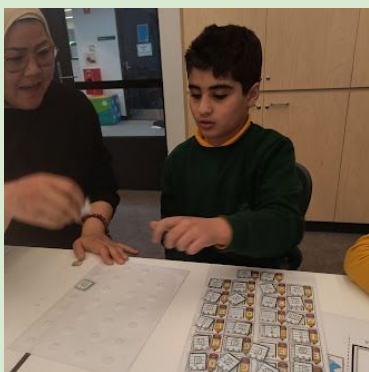
