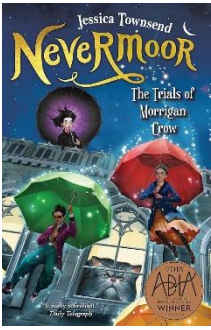


# RECOMMENDED READS



## **Nevermoor : The trials of Morrigan Crow** by Jessica Townsend

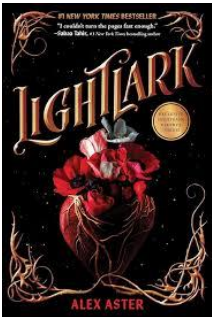

## **Lightlark** by Alex Aster

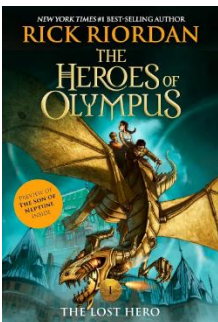
