

The Vigilantes Polypus.

The terrifying species of the Vigilantes Polypus, often known as the “Watching Squid” adapted to the dangerous seaborne species of Mechanica referred to as Aquatica. It is possibly one of the most powerful species of all Aquatica automatrons.

Its appearance is truly horrifying and intriguing and is honestly amazing to look at. It is powered by a state of the art Childress F120 Fusion Unit that is embedded in a small capton under its red wires. Its “eyes” are clear glass bulbs, covering tiny control panels that optimise its optical sensors, giving it 3D mapping of its surroundings and great vision. The Watching Squid has many extremely strong tentacles, but his two longest tentacles are by far his most dangerous. On the tips of those two longest tentacles are steel plates and on the very tip of those, are microscopic bright red buttons that it uses to sting its prey. Its other tentacles are thin and flexible, making it perfect for choking its prey as well as stinging it. Its fat rocket shaped head, scientifically called the mantle, is bolted on at the bottom to ensure it stays connected.

Weighing in at a whopping 11,000 kilograms and being measured at an amazing 9.7 metres wide, this species of Aquatica is an absolute beast!
