Year 7 Learning Program

The Year 7 curriculum has a dedicated focus on Literacy and Numeracy in English and Mathematics classes. Students will also study Humanities, Science, Languages other than English (LOTE), Physical Education, Arts and Technology subjects. Each semester Year 7 students will have a Quest in Humanities and Science, which allow students to investigate real world applications of these subjects while applying literacy learning skills.
