## Learning and Teaching Report - Term 2, Week 9, 2023

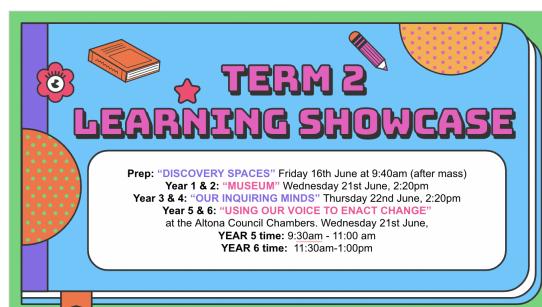
### Sacred Heart Feast Day

### SACRED HEART WINTER WARMTH DONATION DRIVE

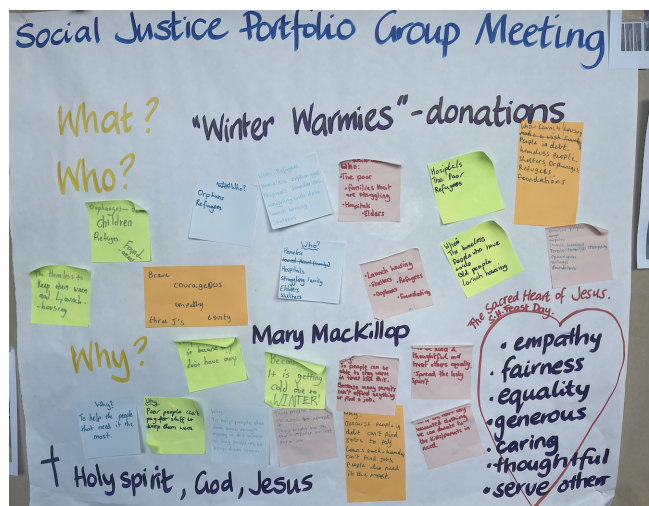
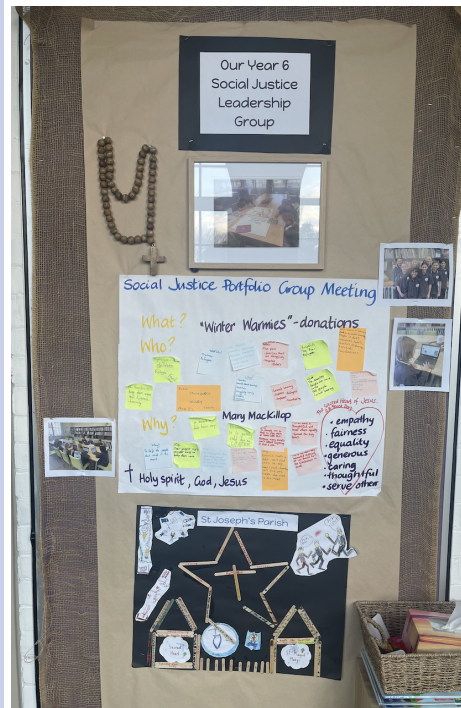
