FEES FOR TERMS 1 & 2, 2024.

(Please note that fees for Term 1 & 2 are combined. The below fee's are also adjusted if a lesson falls on a public holiday, school camp, curriculum day, etc.)

DRUMS (Grade 3 - 6) = \$260. GUITAR (Grade 3 - 6) = \$260. UKULELE (Grade 1 - 6) = \$260. SINGING (Grade 2 - 6) = \$260. BASS GUITAR (Grade 3 - 6) = \$260. KEYBOARD (Grade 2 - 6) = \$260. (Wednesday's with Lisette)

KEYBOARD (Foundation - Grade 1) = \$240. (Monday's with Andrew)

DISCOUNTS.....

If enrolling multiple siblings a \$10 discount applies to each enrolment. If paying by CASH a \$20 discount applies to each enrolment. All payments are GST inclusive.

Requirements:

All students of Keyboard, Guitar, Bass Guitar, Ukulele and Singing are required to bring a plastic pocket folder to every class (available from Officeworks/Kmart for a few dollars). Ukulele students are required to bring their own ukulele to every lesson. Mahalo Ukulele is

recommended. Drum students are required to bring their own drum sticks to every lesson. Drum Sticks size 5A

with wooden tips is recommended. Guitar and Bass Guitar students are required to bring their own picks/plectrums to every lesson. Guitar and Bass Guitar students are welcomed to bring their own guitars.

To purchase the required musical instruments I recommend Billy Hydes Music in Flemington.

The following Terms and Conditions of Enrolment apply:

- 1. Lessons are held on a weekly basis and are 30 minutes in duration within school hours.
- 2. The commitment for tuition is for a minimum of the invoiced period.
- 3. Notification of withdrawal from the program must be submitted
- by email to Andrew Nunns only. Not your child's classroom teacher or the office.
- 4. All IMP students work in groups of approximately 6 and under.
- All payments are to be handled by Andrew Nunns School of Music. Cash and Direct Deposit are only accepted. Please see payment form for further details.
- Lessons missed due to instrumental teacher absence, school excursions, sport days, etc will be made up where possible or a credit will be given to the following term account.
 The last week of each term is not an invoiced week, this is left for make up lessons if required.
- 7. If your child decides not to continue with the ANSOM lessons at any point during the terms a refund will not be processed.

Some artists he has previously performed and toured with include Underground Lovers, Lime Spiders, The Welcome Mat, Sarah Blasko, Adalita (Magic Dirt), Grant McLennan (Go Betweens) and GB3/Steve Kilbey (The Church).

At 12 years of age Gary started performing (singing/guitar) with his father, playing Everly Brothers songs at parties. He is an accomplished musician who has been playing professionally for 44 years and teaching for the past 19 years, 17 of those at ENPS. Gary is a very sort after musician who currently plays guitar and sings in the bands, Scarecrow – The Mellencamp Show, The Eagles Story, Come Together (The Beatles Tribute), The Rusty Nails and Solo acoustic. Some artists he has previously performed and toured with include Glenn Shorrock (Little River Band), Wendy Matthews, Doug Parkinson, Ross Wilson (Daddy Cool), Jon Stevens (Noiseworks/INXS), Richard Clapton, Joe Camilleri and Eric Burden.
